Rod Formulas

As a reminder please show your fellow drivers respect when on track and remember it is NON-CONTACT racing. Sometimes contact does happen but we must do our best to avoid it.

Also if a car is approx. 3/4ths up the inside of you, you must give that car the respect and they now have the inside line and not turn in on them. This has been an unwritten rule (which will be added to the existing written rules) for about 60 years in Oval Racing.

The pit area (including the camping area) is not a test track, so its 5mph everywhere! Also no passengers to be carried in the cars in the pits. Also you can't side on trailers, flatbeds etc when in the pits. Pit Safety is a must!

Drivers need to stop pit lane racing, in particular drivers parking their car in line but not staying within their car and instead walking off. This causes all sorts of problems, and potentially quite serious especially when it's near the ambulance area.

With effect from 5th March the levy has been increased to £2-00, this is all formulas & all Promotions.

Drivers are reminded that they cannot race at non ORCi circuits whilst they hold an ORCi Licence.

FUEL NON RETURN VALVES

Fuel Non return valves were included as an ORCi requirement in Oval Race formulae some time ago.

In 2016 there was a high profile case involving a Non return valve not being fitted in a particular formula that was dealt with somewhat leniently at the time given some more general issues with regards their fitting and scrutineering with the anticipation that this would be an example to raise the awareness to all drivers that a fully operational/working Non return valve **MUST** be fitted.

In recent weeks various investigations have revealed that drivers continue to abuse the rule from taking cars to scrutineering and then removing them or fitted and tampered with.

From the 1st May 2017 drivers are now warned that contravention of this rule **WILL** result in an automatic mandatory ban under the technical rules/ penalties of 6 months. This applies to any driver not having a fully working non return valve fitted and/or it being tampered with in any way.

Driver Helmets

The ORCi have reviewed the current safety specification standards for driver helmets, and now issue the following additions/changes to existing ORCi rules for the 2017 season, effective immediately.

Adult Helmets (Drivers aged 16 and over)

- **Change** – Helmets certified to the **Snell SA 2005** specification will **continue** to be **accepted** for use during the 2017 season. This acceptance will be reviewed again at the end of the year, in line with other motorsport sanctioning bodies.
 - **New** – Helmets certified to the following newer standards are permitted for use in all ORCi formulas. These are **ADDITIONAL** permitted standards to those currently allowed.
 - Snell EA2016 [For Elite Automotive sports]
 - FIA 8860-2010 [Updated version of 8860-2004]
 - FIA 8859-2015 [Premium Helmets]
 - SFI 31.1 [Updated/merged version of 31.1A and 31.2A]

Youth Helmets (Drivers aged 15 and under)

- **New** – Helmets certified to one or more of the following standards are permitted for use by youth drivers aged 15 and under. These are **ADDITIONAL** permitted standards to those currently allowed.
 - Snell CMR 2007
 - Snell CMS 2007
 - Snell CMR 2016
 - Snell CMS 2016
 - SFI 24.1

Diffs must be free, and not locked or LSD's.
