Rookie Banger (including Lady Rookies) Rule update 18th March

After discussion at the drivers meeting on the 3rd March we have reviewed the radiator rule, this new ruling comes into affect from the next meeting on the 7th April.

15. Radiators

1. Radiators are free & may be moved to any position in the engine bay.
2. Electric cooling fans may be wired through a separate switch.
3. A bulkhead water tank maybe fitted, must not go further forward on the passenger side than the centre line of the turret, driver side must not go forward at all, meaning NO U-shaped tanks. These must not be bolted to the turret and bulkhead bolts must not be connected to door plates or floor plates.

Internet Abuse

Please note anything put on Face book or other social media by a driver or someone associated with a driver can be subject to disciplinary action.

Bridge Stairs

Reminder to all, please do not stand or sit on the stairs to the bridge near race control, the stairs must be clear at all times.

Drivers Log Books

Drivers, it is important that you remember to sign your log book as soon as you receive it

Pit area

The pit area (including the camping area) is not a test track, so its 5mph everywhere! No passengers to be carried in the cars in the pits, and also you can't ride on moving trailers, flatbeds etc when in the pits. Pit Safety is a must!

Drivers need to stop pit lane racing, in particular drivers parking their car in line but not staying within their car and instead walking off. This causes all sorts of problems, and potentially quite serious especially when it's near the ambulance area.

Signing in

Because of the changes at the Raceway, signing in is now done in new pit office, (not at the pit gate). On arrival, park up and go to sign in **BEFORE** going to scrutineering. Your mechanic must go with you to get admission, you will need your log book with you for stamping. (Mechanics trotting along with your logbook at a later time will not gain admission). The only entrance from the pits to the stadium arena for pedestrians is via the new gateway or at the turnstiles. Only towing vehicles with race cars for the event that day are allowed into the pits. Drivers, when going to sign in, please don't drive to the Pit office, and leave you car in the walk way, please walk .And also transporters can't park in the area next to the old building on either side close to the pits office, thanks

Alcohol

All drivers are reminded that drinking alcohol before & during a race meeting is not allowed.

If you are involved in an accident on track, the authorities may well breathalyse you, and there maybe consequences. Also if you have to be seen by the First Aid & go to hospital, there is a chance that you cannot receive treatment .We do have breathalysers at the stadium, and as per the rule book, any driver can be tested through the meeting.

Fuel Caps

After an issue with a fuel cap coming astray during the course of the race, and this was with a National formula, not domestic, with this formula, the drivers mark their fuel caps with their race number, helping officials deal with the issue of a car with no fuel cap far easier. So can we suggest that drivers of our domestic formulas follow suit, and write your race number on your fuel cap, as it is as much benefit to yourselves and fellow drivers as it is to the track staff. This is not compulsory, but is advisory.

Pit Lane

Just a polite reminder, about not lining up in the pit lane too soon please. The hard standing area of the pits is particularly congested this early in the season as we await the back field to dry up with some better weather. Everyone naturally tries to park on the dry/hard standing - which we fully understand. However it does cause extra chaos in the pit lane if more than the next race is actually in line! Therefore nobody should be more than one race too early please, and we must never block the access around the First Aid/Ambulance area at any time.

Parking Reminder

No extra vehicles allowed in the pits, no dropping off tools etc. Also the Area next to the pit lane (old shed) and the walk way to the Pit Office and the track is a NO PARKING AREA.

As a reminder to all drivers, no extra vehicles in the pits. And please park where told too and remember the pits are Max 5mph.

Staff are also reminded they need to park in the main car park not the pits, thanks

Booking in to Race

Thank you to all the drivers that take the time to book in to race, as by booking in to race, it enables us to give out accurate booking lists for the public, and also enables us to plan the race formats for the meeting. It is especially important to book in for Championship meetings to enable us to finalise grids etc. We know that is not always possible, but if you do intend on racing, but unsure on whether you are able to due to work etc, then you can always book in on a provisional booking, so we know that you are intending on racing if circumstances enable you to, and then you can confirm or withdraw the booking nearer to the date of the meeting. Just as it is important to book in, it is equally important to cancel a booking if you have already booked in to race, and for whatever reason you can no longer honour that booking. It would be nice to think that we could get to 100% bookings.
