UK Championship Speedweekend 2018.

Saturday 23rd June & Sunday 24th June is the UK Championship weekend for all of our Domestic formulas.

All races on Saturday for 1300 Saloons, Rookie Bangers, Gt Hot Rods are qualifying rounds for UK Championships, to determine grid positions for the Championship races, which are the first races scheduled for Sunday 24th June.

UK Championship for the MD Hot Rods & Junior Rods, are the last races for your formulas on Sunday lined up in points order from the races over the two days, Lady Rookies the UK Champion is the highest point's scorer over the two days.

Racing starts prompt at 3.30pm on Saturday and Sunday at 12 noon. Pit gates open at 1pm on Saturday it's really important you do not arrive before that time. You can stay overnight at the Stadium, Driver is no charge, but everyone else is £20 per unit..

As there are lots of races, we need to sort the race format out; Drivers wanting to race should book in ASAP Text 07798868947 or email drivers@skegway.info. As well as booking in it's as important to cancel your booking if you are not able to attend, again on any of the above numbers.

On Sunday 24th June, remember to sign in at the pit gate to get your log book date stamped BEFORE you go to scrutineering.

GT Hot Rods & Junior Rods Harry Wright Memorial

On Monday 28th May see's the GT Hot Rods & Junior Rods, race in memory of Harry Wright, who sadly passed away earlier this year, aged just 24yrs old.

Harry started racing in 2006 at the age of 12, fast progressing through the grades up to red grade, and finishing his time in Junior Rods with the Gold Roof in 2009.

In 2010 saw Harry begin his adult racing career, in GT Hot Rods, although cut short due to illness.

Barry Disdel is putting up a trophy & money on the meeting final for the GT Rods, and further sponsorship from Allens Haulage, and Darrell Hardy, is sponsoring the Junior Rods.

There will be a drivers meeting for both GT's & Juniors in the shed at 12.20 prior to the start of racing.



All drivers are reminded that drinking alcohol before & during a race meeting is not allowed.

If you are involved in an accident on track, the authorities may well breathalyse you, and there may be consequences. Also if you have to be seen by the First Aid & go to hospital, there is a chance that you cannot receive treatment. We do have breathalysers at the stadium, and as per the rule book, any driver can be tested through the meeting.

Booking in to Race

Thank you to all the drivers that take the time to book in to race, as by booking in to race, it enables us to give out accurate booking lists for the public, and also enables us to plan the race formats for the meeting. It is especially important to book in for Championship meetings to enable us to finalise grids etc. We know that is not always possible, but if you do intend on racing, but unsure on whether you are able to do work etc, then you can always book in on a provisional booking, so we know that you are intending on racing if circumstances enable you to, and then you can confirm or withdraw the booking nearer to the date of the meeting. Just as it is important to book in, it is equally important to cancel a booking if you have already booked in to race, and for whatever reason you can no longer honour that booking. It would be nice to think that we could get to 100% bookings.

Booking in has never been easier, you can either book in by text (or reply to the booking texts when sent out) on **07798868947**, by email to drivers@skegway.info or via the **Skegness Raceway Drivers page** on Face book, either by private message or when a provisional booking list goes on, put your booking in the comments.

Please note, any Junior Banger driver NOT registered to Skegness Raceway, MUST book in via their own promotion and must have a licence/log book to race at Skegness

If you have not yet registered & applied for your log book, it's really important to arrive at the raceway early, and bring along a completed form, TWO PASSPORT SIZE PHOTOS & money. If you do not bring photos, you must pay for a day licence each time you race.

A full licence must still be paid for (day licence payments do not accumulate to pay for a full licence) please bring photos !!!!

If you have sent off for your log book, we don't post them out, as long as they are complete they will be at the pit office when you first race at Skegness Raceway.

Because of the changes at the Raceway, signing in is now done in new pit office, (not at the pit gate). On arrival, park up and go to sign in **BEFORE** going to scrutineering. Your mechanic must go with you to get admission, you will need your log book with you for stamping. (Mechanics trotting along with your logbook at a later time will not gain admission). The only entrance from the pits to the stadium arena for pedestrians is via the new gateway or at the turnstiles.

Only towing vehicles with race cars for the event that day are allowed into the pits.

Rules for 2018 are on www.skegway.info , please check them. It is the Drivers responsibility to present your car for racing to the correct spec.

It is also the Drivers responsibility, to line up in the correct grade. If you have won a race on that day then you must line up at the back of your grade for the remaining races, all Championship holders must also line up in the correct place. You may well be docked places for not lining up in the correct place.

Roof Pillars/Colours

With a number of newly built & refurbished cars, we feel it is of a necessity to remind you of how you paint your car roof & roof pillars.

Cars will not be permitted to have Gold or Silver Roof Pillars, down to the bottom of the window openings, apart from the relevant Champions who hold the Gold or Silver Roof.

We feel this will add to the prestige of winning either (or both) of these championships, and to wear Gold or Silver, you have to go out and earn it.

And your roof must be painted in a neutral non grading colour or championship colour, unless you choose to denote your grading status by a coloured roof, rather than denote your grading by your roof fin.

Roof Fins

Drivers please can you make sure your roof fin is very clearly numbered, especially Rookie Banger drivers. Snowy had real problems reading the numbers of several cars last season. Any drivers whose race number the lap scorer has issues reading, will be logged and must be rectified prior to the next meeting. They must be black numbers on a white background, or white numbers on a black background, unless the background colour denotes the drivers grading

Pit area

*The pit area (including the camping area) is not a test track, so its 5mph everywhere! No passengers to be carried in the cars in the pits, and also you can't ride on moving trailers, flatbeds etc when in the pits. Pit Safety is a must!

Drivers need to stop pit lane racing, in particular drivers parking their car in line but not staying within their car and instead walking off. This causes all sorts of problems, and potentially quite serious especially when it's near the ambulance area.

Internet Abuse

Please note anything put on Face book or other social media by a driver or someone associated with a driver can be subject to disciplinary action.

Non Contact Formulas

As a reminder please show your fellow drivers respect when on track and remember it is NON-CONTACT racing. Sometimes contact does happen but we must do our best to avoid it.

Also if a car is approx. 3/4ths up the inside of you, you must give that car the respect and they now have the inside line and not turn in on them. This has been an unwritten rule (which will be added to the existing written rules) for about 60 years in Oval Racing.

Bridge Stairs

Reminder to all, please do not stand or sit on the stairs to the bridge near race control, the stairs must be clear at all times.

Drivers, it is important that you remember to sign your log book as soon as you receive it.

1. Tyres and Wheels

Standard wheels 5 ½ J MAXIMUM. The only wheel with camber allowed is front passenger wheel which may have up to 1inch

155 x 70 x 13, Current remould tyres may still be used, or any budget road going tyre.

BMW wheels are not allowed. **A list of tyres NOT allowed is available**

(Tyres will be monitored at all times and if anyone uses a tyre that is not within the nature of the formula, a control tyre may be enforced) No competition tyres, no mud and snow.
